Top of Sign: 15-pound HDU routed to custom shape on 4' x 8' computer controlled Shop Bot backed with 1/2" MDO and hand painted with 1 Shot paints. Bottom of Sign: Lexan material overlaid with High Performance Calon vinyl, Shop Bot router cut 3-ml Komatex letters cut out and overlaid with high performance Calon vinyl; 1/2" MDO wood support structure build around curved Lexan.

2' x 4' oval 1.5" Sign Foam 3 backed with 1/2" MDO. Sign Foam 3 finials and trim, 1/2" MDO phone panel, 4" x 4" cedar posts. Painted with 100 percent Rhino Paint acrylic and 23-karat gold leaf, all on a sandblasted background.

Double-face Sign Foam, sandblasted with Grain Fraim fade, also sandblasted faux brick end caps. HDU moon and wolf. Copper wire from Microfoam covered in Avery vinyl. Dibond ticket appliqué bent for more dimension.
